



2010 Protocol for Shipped Semen

To make breeding season run as smoothly as possible, please note the following Shipped Semen Protocol.

- 1.) Breeding contract must be signed and returned to Babcock Ranch before any shipment will be sent.
- 2.) All breeding fees (book fee, stud fee, and shipping fees) and all outstanding account balances must be paid in full **BEFORE** any shipment will be sent.
- 3.) Coordinate all shipments in advance.
- 4.) Notify the Babcock Office:
 - a. When mare is coming into heat
 - b. No less than 24 hours before you expect to need a shipment.
- 5.) Contact the Babcock Office no later than 10:00 on the day **BEFORE** we collect to cancel or confirm your mare to our breeding schedule for the following day.
- 6.) **Cancellations made after 9:00 am CST the day of the shipment will be charged for the shipment.**

Mister Dual Pep AND Chicks Acky Braky

will only ship Counter to Counter.

Mares to be bred to **Smart Chic Olena, Elans Playboy, Bueno Fritzi Nic, Lucky Little Lena, and Captain Nice** will be required to come to Babcock Ranch for insemination.

There will be absolutely **no shipped semen** available on these stallions.

Mares on the premises of Babcock Ranch have breeding priority on any given day, therefore NO GUARANTEE is made regarding the availability of cooled semen for any specific day. Babcock Quarter Horses, Inc. is not responsible for any untimely delivery or condition of the cooled semen, as we have no control of conditions after a shipment leaves Babcock Ranch.
